

**PRESBYTERY OF THE TWIN CITIES AREA
REPORT OF STATED CLERK
JULY 12, 2011**

1. I'm reporting that, in reference to a recent PJC case of this Presbytery, the date for filing an appeal has passed, and the Prosecuting Committee did not file a request for appeal of the decision. Therefore this case is officially closed and no further action will be forthcoming.

I would like to thank, on your behalf, the Prosecuting Committee. The members were Elder Gayle DeHaan, Elder Chaz Nove, and Rev. Neil Craigan. Rev. Anita Cummings had also served on the Investigating Committee.

I will also announce that, since it is very important that all sessions have access to the new *Books of Order* this time, the Presbytery is sending two copies to each church; one for the clerk of session and one for the moderator. I strongly urge sessions to purchase copies for all session members. In case you haven't noticed in reports, most of the Presbytery committees who might be affected the most by the new Form of Government and the several additional amendments passed by the presbyteries have passed a motion to continue following processes in place until such time as they have had an opportunity to make any structural changes they might wish to make in accordance with this edition of the *Book of Order*. At the next meeting of Presbytery, I will be presenting an outline of the changes in the Constitution.
